C.N. and V. v. France – 4 years domestic servitude

Nanterre Criminal Court awards EUR 24,000 for all damages without distinguishing between pecuniary and non-pecuniary dimensions

ECtHR awards on an equitable basis EUR 30,000

Elizabeth Kawogo against the UK – 10 months domestic servitude

Employment Tribunal awards GBP 58,585 (~ EUR 66,000) for unpaid wages, holiday pay, failure to provide employment contract

ECtHR awards EUR 18,000 in moral damages for failure to investigate trafficking

Chowdury and others v. Greece – between 2 and 6 months labor exploitation

ECtHR awards on an equitable basis EUR 16,000 each, for unpaid wages and moral damage
