On 23 January, a provisional agreement has been reached on the revision of the EU directive on preventing and combating trafficking in human beings. The Directive now includes a binding obligation for EU Member States to criminalise people who *knowingly use* services provided by trafficked persons.

As you have been the ones supported this decision, we call upon you to set the right example as EU citizens: **Ensure that you do not make use of trafficked persons' services.**
